For the Author:

- Tell your audience what you want them to listen for.
- Ask your audience's opinion if you are not sure about a certain phrase or word, or if one way of saying something sounds better than another.
- When you are finished reading, ask your audience what they liked best or what they want to hear more about.
- Take notes on what you want to fix as you read to the audience.

- Retell the piece in your own words.
- Respond to what the author asked you to listen to.
- Is everything clear? If not, say what isn't.
- Tell what parts you liked best and why.
- Tell what you'd like to hear more about.
