## Eastside Literacy Tutor Support Student Handout -Telephone Spelling

It is often difficult to hear and understand letters when someone is spelling aloud in English, especially over the telephone. It is helpful to use phonetic alphabets to clarify what you are saying or hearing.

## Examples:

Explaining: "My name is Kei—K as in king, E as in Edward; I as in Ida." Clarifying: "Did you mean B as in baker or D as in David?"
