If you didn't have a telephone, how would you communicate with other people?

How do you like to communicate with people? Do you prefer using the telephone, computer, speaking in person, or writing a letter?

How would cooking be different if you had no oven, microwave, refrigerator, freezer, or faucet?

What is your favorite kind of technology? Why? Can you imagine life without this kind of technology?

Which statement do you agree with? Why?

What do you think about people who listen to music while walking down the street?

What do you think about people who talk on their cell phones loudly?

Do you think children should play video games or play outside? Why?
